Explain Everything Interactive Whiteboard

This app allows you to create videos. It has an interactive screencasting whiteboard. Tools include a laser pointer, drawing, adding shapes, text, mathematical equations, videos, images and audio files.

You can rotate, move, scale, flip, copy, paste, clone and lock any object added to the whiteboard.

You can record everything going on on the whiteboard and even add a video of yourself using the front-facing camera.

Your video can be downloaded in various file types and exported to different file managing platforms.
